Term 1	New Testament Survey 1	11 th Feb – 1 st April
	This subject aims to equip you with foundational knowledge of the New Testament by exploring the culture, background, authorship and purpose of many of the New Testament books. Covering the Gospel accounts (Matthew, Mark, Luke and John), the Acts of the Apostles, key Pauline teaching (Romans, 1 & 2 Corinthians and Galatians), and the Prison Letters (Colossians, Philemon and Philippians), with a focus on an introduction to the world of the New Testament with the intention of appropriate application to our current world.	
Term 2	New Testament Survey 2	29 th Apr – 17 th Jun
	This module, although not consecutive to New Testament Survey 1, provides an overview of the remaining New Testament Books. Including Ephesians, 1 & 2 Thessalonians, 1 & 2 Timothy, Titus, Hebrews, James, 1 & 2 Peter, Jude, 1, 2 & 3 John, and Revelation. This includes an exploration of key biblical contexts with the intention to better understand the biblical text and apply it to our current world.	
Term 3	Christian Doctrine 1	15 th Jul – 2 nd Sep
	Christian Doctrine 1 has 8 sessions. Students will study 4 key areas of Christian Doctrine; what they are and how they apply to their lives as disciples of Christ.	
Term 4	Christian Doctrine 2	30 th Sep – 18 th Nov
	Christian Doctrine 2 has eight sessions. Students will study 4 key areas of Christian Doctrine: salvation, the church, eternal states spiritual beings. Students will have the opportunity to explore each doctrine, discussing what they are and how they apply to their lives as disciples of Christ.
