Connect Questions

- 1. The book of Acts does not have a finish in Greek it is an incomplete sentence it is a hanging sentence. It essentially means YOU FINISH THE STORY! We are called to join the story and preach the gospel. The Church was never meant to hold onto the Gospel message for ourselves, but we have been empowered to be "witnesses" (Acts 1:8) of Jesus Christ and have been given the Holy Spirit to empower us as we do so. The purpose of this gathering is to scatter so that the lives of believers are living as salt and light in their community. Discuss what this means for you and your cg.
- 2. Do you see yourself as a builder, contributing and expanding upon what the apostles (and Paul) started in Acts? Discuss.
- 3. What is your next step to use the gifts God has given you to build His kingdom?
- 4. What do you think being salt and light in the arenas of your life actually looks like? Salt is used to preserve food and light illuminates dark spaces. Is it an attitude, a particular action or task you have seen that does these things?
- 5. Have you ever had an experience of continuing a project, someone else started? What were the challenges and the blessings?
- 6. Is there a particular ministry area mentioned at Vision Builders that you feel passionate about? How about committing to pray for that ministry regularly this year or getting involved somehow? Discuss.
- 7. As we follow Jesus' command to go into all the earth, how will you be a part of Vision Builders in 2025 and be a mobilised member of the body of Christ?

Why are we vision builders?

Acts 2:17-21

'In the last days, God says, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your young men will see visions, your old men will dream dreams.

18 Even on my servants, both men and women, I will pour out my Spirit in those days, and they will prophesy. I will show wonders in the heavens above and signs on the earth below, blood and fire and billows of smoke.

20 The sun will be turned to darkness and the moon to blood before the coming of the great and glorious day of the Lord.

21 And everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.'

Paul is in Rome preaching the gospel as people came to visit him...

Acts 28:31

31 He proclaimed the kingdom of God and taught about the Lord Jesus Christ—with all boldness and without hindrance!

We are Acts 29...

From the beginning declaration found in Mark to the spread of the gospel to Jerusalem (Acts 1-8), Judea, Samaria and to the ends of the earth in Acts 28 (Rome), we are called to join the story and preach the gospel.

Mark 16:15 (ESV)

And he said to them, "Go into all the world and proclaim the gospel to the whole creation."

The Church was never meant to hold onto the Gospel message for ourselves, but we have been empowered to be "witnesses" (Acts 1:8) of Jesus Christ and have been given the Spirit to empower us as we do so. The purpose of this gathering is to scatter so that the lives of believers are living as salt and light in their community (Matthew 5:13-16).

Acts 1:8 But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

We are vision builders because the story of Jesus' Church and its impact on the world for the glory of God is not over! We are the continuation of the book of Acts.
